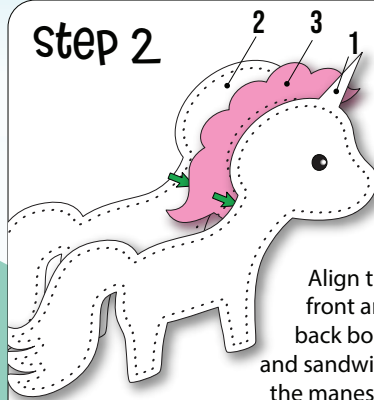
step 1



Put in the craft eye through the eye hole and push on the backing until you hear a click.

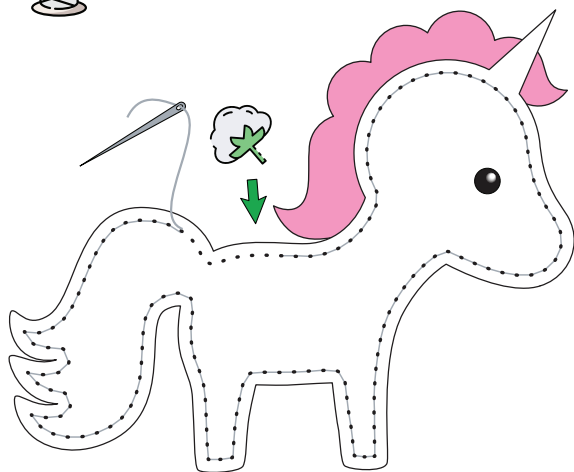
step 2



Align the front and back body and sandwich the manes in between. Keep everything in place with a few pins.

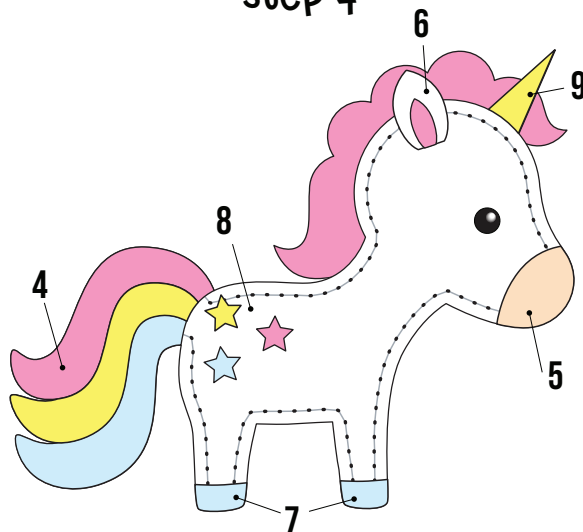


step 3



Sew all around the body, tail and head of the unicorn with white thread. Leave a small gap so you can add some filling to the body before closing it completely.

step 4

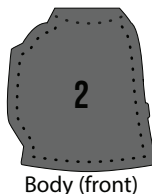
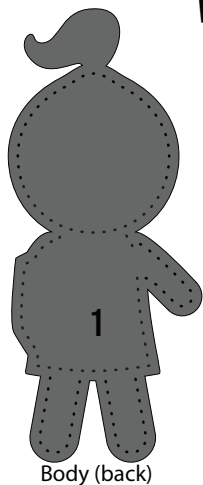


Peel of the sticker backings and stick the horn, ear, stars, tail stripes, snout and hooves onto the unicorn as shown.

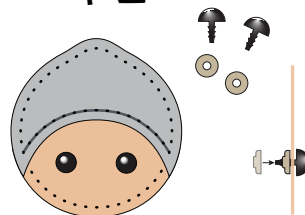


step 1

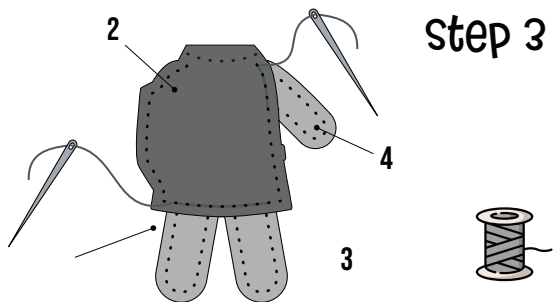


Align the face and helmet and sew along the forehead with grey thread.

step 2

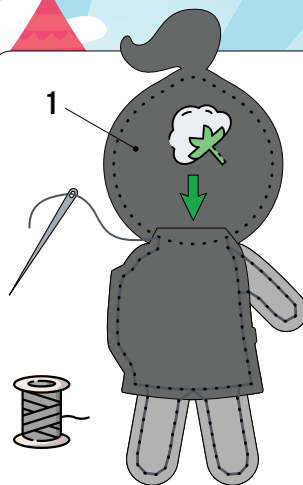


Put in the craft eyes through the eye holes and push on the backings until you hear a click.



step 3

Align the front of the body with the legs and arm. Sew along the hemline of the body and shoulder with grey thread.



step 4

Align the front of the body with the back of the body and keep it in place with a few pins. Sew all around the body, legs and arm with grey thread. Start at one shoulder and end at the other. Add some filling via the neck opening (we will close the neck in step 5).



step 5

Align the face with the rest of the body and sew around it with grey thread. Leave a small gap so you can add some filling before closing it completely.

step 6

Peel of the sticker backings and stick the visor, visor hinges, plume, hair, shield, belt and shoes on the knight as shown.
